

We had a little fella that frequented the Pregnancy Help Centre for a few months with his new foster mom. It was her first newborn and she came in for support and care as she parented this wonderful little boy. He was in his early days, just born, and we watched him grow. He is a beautiful, happy, engaged baby.

Then one day, the foster mom was given notice that the baby would be moving to another city closer to his birthmother. On his last day at the Centre, the volunteers assembled around him with one of our clients, Karina (not her real name, of course), and we prayed for God's hand of protection on his life and his new foster home. There were tears of sadness as we said goodbye, but also a sense of hope for his life and what God would do!

Not long after, Karina asked for a pregnancy test. She had children already - that's why she was using our services. The test was positive. Her partner didn't want more children and she felt that she would be unable to care for another, especially if she had to do so on her own. She quickly decided that she would have an abortion. It is not unusual for women to automatically consider abortion when they discover a surprise pregnancy.

Karina reached out to let us know she couldn't parent another child. And then something wonderful happened. She came in for her regular visit and told us that she was reconsidering the abortion. She was so touched by the care she had seen for the little fella. He was very loved. It challenged her to consider placing the expectant baby into adoptive care. She believed, after having seen how well the foster mom had cared for the baby entrusted to her, that her baby could be loved and find a safe home too.

What joy in sadness! Someone had watched the foster parenting experience and decided that her baby could have a future! Please remember Karina - God knows - for courage, for strength, for hope. You never know who is watching and what God will do through you.


Wonderfully Made was featured at our Friends of the PHC Dinner. If you were there, we had opportunity to celebrate the miracle of you.
