As it was our first week back after the Christmas holiday, we didn't want to be closed. We creatively switched around our Monday and Friday volunteers so we were able to remain open.

While we were caring for our clients (who were excited to be back in the centre after the break) Jennifer walked in. She had looked us up online and came in for help. Specifically, she wanted an abortion. She had just discovered she was pregnant and she felt an urgency to take care of her problem. We have a lot of people who call in or come in for abortions.

We brought her to the intake room and barely got started in our interview when she realized that we would not be providing her with an abortion. The appointment did not last very long, but our volunteer shared a bit of her own story and suggested that there were other options that she may want to consider as she wouldn't want to have regrets in the future. Jennifer was pretty eager to leave and our volunteer continued on with her day, unsure of the outcome of that conversation. Our volunteers are trained to have the conversation, to share Jesus if they have opportunity and to maintain a gracious and prayerful attitude to all the people we meet.

About a week and a half later, on a Monday, Jennifer returned, She came to tell the person who had met with her that she had thought about their meeting and that she didn't want to have regrets in her life. She decided to not pursue an abortion. Of course, because it was a Monday, she was able to tell that volunteer directly, who had been filling in on that very first Friday.

What an encouragement and an answer to prayer! We don't always know the outcome, but what a happy and tear-filled day it was. God is good.


